Athletic Committee Meeting
Monday, August 22, 7 p.m.

Josh Craighead opened the meeting in prayer.

1. Apparel

Danielle Stubbs talked to the committee about athletics apparel design and sales. She has been doing apparel sales for Des Moines Christian School for 7 years. She said she sold \$50,000 in wear last year. She presented her ideas for selling ACA athletic apparel. She has an art degree and can do her own designs. She will come up with some designs for ACA apparel.

2. Concessions

Karen Alessio reported on purchases for concessions. She will use Costco and Farner-Bocken.

3. Football

Jon reported on the upcoming football game. Josh Craighead will run admissions. Bob Snyder will be announcer and Doug Reed will run the scoreboard.

Jon said ACA-ICA cheerleaders want to use the Eagle mascot. Committee said it should be released to an adult and its use closely supervised.

Jon said Amy Schatz will lead a cheerleading clinic with the students performing at the football game on Sept. 23 at Saydel.

The committee agreed that ICA needs to pay ACA \$500 for football by Wednesday for ICA cards to admit their fans to football games, otherwise ICA fans will need to pay to get into games.

Doug Kuhles has resigned as junior high football coach. Jon has recommended a candidate who will be presented to the BOE for approval on Thursday (August 25).

4. Volleyball

Phil Swift reported 18 girls are out for volleyball. Chris Snyder and Kelly Brown are doing stats. He said there is still a need for line judges and scoreboard operators. Karen will get carpool and concessions schedules out.

5. Pancake Breakfast and Car Wash

6. Miscellaneous

Steve Stocks suggested that the pop machines be removed and an apparel display and sales area be placed in that spot. Josh said we may have a contract that requires the pop machines stay in the school.

Karen Swift asked about scoreboard ads and the ads on the score table. Josh said he would talk to the manager at the Ankeny Hy-Vee about renewing the score table ad. Jon will look for the contracts.

Liz reported that she is getting the girls golf banners updated and a banner made for the boys golf sectional championship. The banner for the boys had to be reordered because it did not match the girls' golf banners.
