

**ACA Athletic Committee Meeting**  
**Tuesday, March 22, 2011 7 p.m.**

Jon opened the meeting in prayer.

1. February minutes were read and approved. Phil moved. Fred second. Passed.

2. Overview/update of 2011-12 coaches

Jon presented the outline of coaches for next school year. Positions that need to be filled are Head Junior Varsity Coach Football, Assistant Junior Varsity Coach Football, Head Junior High Coach Football, Volunteer Assistant Junior High Football, Head Junior High Coach Volleyball, Head Varsity Coach Girls Basketball, Assistant Varsity Coach Girls Basketball, Head Varsity Coach Boys Basketball, Assistant Varsity Coach Boys Basketball, Head Junior High Coach Boys Basketball.

Bob made a preliminary motion that:

- because athletics is an integral part of ACA
- because athletics draws a lot of attention to the school,
- because athletics attracts students to the school
- because ACA is at a disadvantage in attracting coaches because of the structure of athletics to the school
- because other schools tie together teacher and coaching contracts and salaries
- because other schools pay coaching salaries on a ladder scale based on experience similar to teachers,

that the ACA /BOE partner with the Athletic Committee in paying coaches' salaries in a 50-50 split in 2011-12 with an ultimate goal of the ACA/BOE taking over coaches' salaries. A detailed motion will follow in April.

4. Golf

Liz asked if ACA was willing to host Girls District or Regional Tournament. The application needs to be turned in by March 25. ACTION: Liz will check with Woodland Hills about hosting and get back to Jon.

4. Co-Op Agreements

Jon said co-op agreements are due to state athletic associations by April 30.

5. Fundraisers

The committee agreed to submit the following fundraisers: apparel sales, soup suppers, car washes, breakfast with garage sale, fundraisers during halftimes, scoreboard ads, driveway stencils, yard signs, card sales.

#### 6. Weight room

Steve Stocks will supervise weight room, if he can get out of morning teacher devotions.

ACTION: Josh needs to talk with Joyce about excusing Steve from devotions.

#### 7. Iowa AD Convention in Iowa City.

Jon will attend the Iowa AD convention this coming weekend and Monday.

#### 8. Gym rental

Jon moved that all gym rental fees be eliminated for all contracted employees and coaches who wish to have an open gym and/or practice time outside their season and if the coach and/or school employees will serve as the site manager. Additionally if alumni wish to rent the gym, they would only have to pay the reduced rate that we currently charge school families. This policy would apply only when the gym is available and not already rented and/or being used by the school. Randy second. Passed 7-0.

Liz moved that the Olejniczaks be refunded \$40 for rental of the gym that they were charged for the all-star team practice involving Tim. Bob second. Passed 6-0 with one abstention.
