### **Highschool Sports:**

\$125 fee per sport, except for Varsity football - \$200

\$100 fee per sport, except for Jr. High football - \$125

#### **Sports with co-op agreement with other schools:**

Boys/Girls Track with ICA (pending)

### **Homeschool students:**

Pay \$175 non-refundable athletic fee and then each student pays the ACA athletic fee per sport.

### **Union rule on transfers:**

A transfer high school student must wait 90 contact school days before he/she can play at the varsity level at ACA, unless the family has just moved to Ankeny from another city or the student is a freshman that has not attended any other high school. The athlete may play junior varsity sports and may practice with the varsity team during the 90 day waiting period. For further information on this, check with the Athletic Director or the Iowa Boys or Girls Athletic Unions.

### **Parents of Athletes:**

Parents are important to ACA's Athletic program. Parents of athletes are assigned to help in the concession stand, help with gym clean-up, and may be assigned other duties (like taking ticket money, line judging in volleyball.etc.) to help run the program.
