

# A Typical Developmental Kindergarten Day

**Opening:** Calendar, weather, pledges, prayer, songs, and flashcard practice

**Bible:** Bible lessons focus on Old Testament and New Testament Bible stories and include singing Bible songs and weekly Bible verse practice.

**Group Work:** Phonics and handwriting lessons
