

A Typical Kindergarten Day

Opening: Journal writing, pledges, calendar, weather, prayer, and songs

Math Time: Math concepts covered include shapes, identifying and writing numbers to 100, addition, subtraction, and time.

Recess/Restroom Break

Phonics/Handwriting Lesson Time: The students have guided practice time followed by independent work time.

Reading Groups: Students are split into small groups to work on phonics skills and reading.

Social Studies or Science: Both science and social studies lessons are taught two days a week. Science topics include living and non-living things, transportation and materials. Social Studies topics include community helpers, our nation, and countries around the world.
